## Utilizing a Blackout Comms Link

Adding a well-placed Blackout Comms link to your cluster can help in many ways. If you keep a link running in a decent location (say upper-floor window) 24/7, you should see benefits, including extended range, better location (GPS) awareness, a more effective mesh cache, as more devices are available for packet caching. A link does not have to be stationary. It could be in a car or on a drone, for example.



3. Message is delivered from sender's upperfloor link directly to the recipient.

The visual example above shows how a well-placed link will automatically be used to help a message be delivered. Keep in mind, the **link can hold message packets for up to 24 hours**, so the flow you see below does not have to be instant (can be asynchronous).
